

## **Meeting Opened at 13:17.**

- Robert Stanley called to order the annual meeting.

## **Old Business**

- Club Savings / Credits \$3800.00, Club outstanding debts for burm work is \$3000.00
- Shoot House was dropped in favor of wall sections
- Additional wall sections needed instead of shoot house. 10 to 15 more wall sections and another 40 to 50 stands.
- Landscaping needs to be addressed, grass cutting & weed eating.
- Removal of old materials / trash.

## **2010 Goals**

- The review of a local club rule of the 180-degree rule.
- The construction of more range props.
- Securing non-club vendor sponsorship.
- Improving the drainage issues & see about hauling in wood chips to help with the inevitable mud issues.
- Improving the parking area and reconstruction of the burms in bays 1 & 2.
- Raising the needed funds to complete all of the needed range improvements, this can be accomplished by having a minimum of 30 shooters at every match.
- 7 people have committed to the 5-year \$250.00 with the 6<sup>th</sup> year being free program.
- Currently there are 34 members in the club, half on average show up. There needs to be a minimum of 50 club members, with a 75% average attendance ratio of club members.
- Additional wall sections needed instead of shoot house. 10 to 15 more wall sections and another 40 to 50 stands.
- Need more target stands, up & down target stands, runners across each bay.
- Bay design to protect the up & down target stands.
- Cover in each bay for the shooters / spectators. This will protect from the weather. Need prices and funding, look at possible sponsors for the bay covers.

- Looking at placing wood chips in each bay to help with the muddy conditions on raining days. Wood chips will be the most economical approach.
- Storage buildings in each bay.
- Sponsorship, we need it. Look at a Glock style match, Glock style matches generally draw lots of shooters
- Club / Range workdays need to usually will happen on the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month.

### **New Business**

- Bylaw changes are as follows -
- Membership dues are \$60.00 per year instead of \$40.00 per year, subject to review.
- Design and implementation of a program to attract NEW shooters along with the design of a program to improve new shooter retention to a minimum acceptable standard of 50%.
- The Executive committee to review and apply changes to club bylaws and have the changes ready to be voted on by club members on or before September 1, 2010.
- Club members work hours, the hours are valued at \$20.00 per hour with 5 hours annually required, subject to review, committee members will discuss within 2 weeks to come up with a finalized plan.
